

enesis 2:15 And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to ¹⁶And the LORD God keep it. commanded the man, saving, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: ¹⁷But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. God is not a man that He should lie. He says what He means and He means what He says. Adam's job was to dress and keep the garden of Eden. However, whenever you plant a seed (that God planted), the seed planted will be accompanied by weeds (that was planted by Satan) that tends to grow faster than the seed that you planted. The Other 'F' Words Part III

OUNDATION

There's a fairy tale about three little pigs and the houses they built for themselves once they moved out of their parent(s) home ③. Basically, one built a house out of straw. One built a house made of wood (twigs). One made a house built of bricks. There was a wolf that didn't want them to build houses in his territory (personally, I think he may have been hungry and was looking for some bacon, ham, and pork chops but, not my story).

Anyway, the story line goes like this: Pigs left home, built their individual houses, wolf blew the first two down and went after the third house but couldn't blow it down. Why? Building material was too strong for this bad wind bag! He ran into a house that was stronger than the other two. The first two were built with light weight material and the houses went down with little resistance. The third house stood because it was made of strong, substantial material.

Then there's the scriptural example in Mathew 7:24-27 "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock. And everyone who hears these words of mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell, and great was the fall of it."

Notice that the house built on the rock withstood the rain, the floods, and the wind? The house on sand fell. Not a fairy tale but a life lesson in this case. That's what our lives are likened to, spiritually building on a daily basis the place where we live. We can't afford to be frivolous, careless, or cheap about our building material. Our lives will be infiltrated and even bombarded at times with torrential type rains called trouble. It could be prodigal children, untimely deaths, personal losses – homes, jobs, finances, reputation, and health.

The tragedy in the story of the Three Little Pigs is that they all apparently had access to the same material. For whatever reason, two of them decided to use the straw and the wood (twigs) and the wolf blew their houses down. It could have been laziness, convenience, cost, time, the way the material looked, or some other reason but whatever the reason, it cost them their homes. They went light and the wolf destroyed their homes.

Yes, I'm sure the bricks required a bit more work but in the long run, that brick house stood strong against the enemy. How about the winds of adversity in our lives? When trouble comes, will we remain standing? What are we using to build up our spiritual house? Is the foundational integrity of our spiritual lives solid? Can we hold up sure, and secure? There will be unexpected (unwanted) situations to test the building material and the foundation. The material matters. If you're still breathing (if you're still alive), it isn't too late to get it right. Forget pride. Start over if need be but get it right.

John 6:1 After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is the sea of Tiberias. ²And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased. ³And Jesus went up into a mountain, and there he sat with his disciples. ⁴And the passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh. ⁵When Jesus then lifted up his eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat? ⁶And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do. ⁷Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little. 8One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him, ⁹There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many? 10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. ¹¹And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples. Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. 13 Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten. 14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said. This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

he Spirit of that prophet, Jesus Christ, is yet in the world performing miracle after miracle, to those that would dare believe His Word.
