





Hebrews 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. ¹⁶But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. Sometimes my patience wears thin and I wear my thoughts on my face, not on my sleeves. It becomes rather evident that I'm fed up because I get tired of seeing the same cycle of devastation and waste over and over and over again. The names and faces may change but the patterns don't. DRESS FOR SUCCESS IN GOD

an's idea of success is so very different from success from God's perspective. Man equates success with material gains; big house, bank account, fine car; etc. Whereas God's success does not deny those provisions for the child of God, everything goes to motive. To be a success in God is to be like God; and that can only be done if I have His Spirit and am allowing His Spirit to live through me. No, I am not God, for He said thou shall have no other gods before me. Solomon was a very wealthy king because God blessed him. God said in His word in Deuteronomy 8:18 But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day. Please keep in mind that wealth is not confined to money. Here is God's take on the subject as found in 1 Timothy 6:9 But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. Look also at Mark 4:19 And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful. It is not the money but our attitude concerning it. Consider also 1 Timothy 6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;. To be truly dressed for success we need to allow God to dress us up as He tells us in 1 Peter 4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin; When we have the Spirit of Christ, God is able to dress us for success as found in Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. ¹¹Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹²For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. ¹³Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; ¹⁵And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. ¹⁷And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: ¹⁸Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; God instructs us to walk in the Spirit so as not to fulfill the lust of the flesh (Galatians 5:16). God wants our inside clean and pure. If we allow God to dress us, every situation that comes our way, we can handled it in the Lord because He told us to fight the good fight of faith, and lay hold on eternal life. But one thing is very important for us to understand clearly. 1 Samuel 17:47 And all this assembly shall know that the LORD saveth not with sword and spear: for the battle is the LORD'S, and he will give you into our hands. When we were born again of the Spirit of God, we are not our own from that moment on, we belong to the Lord and our purpose is to do the will of God at all times. Test time will come into our lives but be of good cheers; God says in Romans 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. ³⁸For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, ³⁹Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Remember, we are His children and He knows how He want us to look. We walk in the confidence of God knowing that we represent Him at all times.
